

# ZERO TOLERANCE FOR SEXUAL ABUSE AND SEXUAL HARASSMENT

## RIGHT TO REPORT

If you, or someone you know, are experiencing sexual abuse or sexual harassment, Maywood Police Department (MPD) wants to know. We want you to report right away! Why?

- We want to keep YOU safe; it is our job! It is your right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment.
- We want to conduct an investigation of the reported incident.
- We want to hold the perpetrator accountable for his/her actions.
- We want to provide YOU with relevant information and support services.

## HOW TO REPORT

Maywood Police Department offers multiple ways to report sexual abuse and sexual harassment. Reports can be made anonymously.

- Call the Bergen County Prosecutor's Office at (201) 646-2300.
- Report the incident to any MPD staff member.
- Report the incident to the MPD PREA coordinator or MPD Chief of Police.
- Report to an MPD Internal Affairs Officer.
- Tell a family member, friend, legal counsel, or anyone else outside the facility. They can report on your behalf by calling our Internal Affairs at (201) 845-8800.
- You also can submit a report on someone's behalf, or someone at MPD can report for you using the ways listed here.
